Review finds province is leading the way with Water for Life, but more needs to be done

Calgary ... Increasing public awareness and increasing and better targeting funding are two key areas of improvement that can make a good thing even better, according to a comprehensive, objective review of the province's *Water for Life* strategy.

In the Review of Implementation Progress of Water for Life, 2005-2006, released May 1 by the Alberta Water Council – a multi-stakeholder, consensus-based organization responsible for overseeing and monitoring the implementation of the water strategy – the Council states good progress is being made on Water for Life, but by focusing more on a few areas, Alberta can ensure its approach and practices on water management and use are not only sustainable, but are world class.

"Alberta is on the cusp of something great with *Water for Life*," said Bill Berzins, Chair of the Bow River Basin Council and one of the co-chairs of the Alberta Water Council. "The actions of the first three years have established a foundation for future initiatives, and now it is vital that the province takes full advantage of the increased funding that has been committed in the past year."

Ron Pearson, the Council member who led the review team, said the Government of Alberta deserves recognition for this progress, but noted that significant challenges also remain.

"We believe it is now the opportune time to renew and resource the *Water for Life* strategy and commit sustained financial support to ensure its success," said Pearson, who serves as a non-governmental organization representative on the Council on behalf of Trout Unlimited Canada.

The Council also recommends that an increase in public awareness and understanding on water issues and conservation should continue to be a key priority, as it is an activity that not only impacts all of the other initiatives, but it is also one that can net short-term results.

"In the long run, we believe the wise use of water, through the effective management of demand is a critical component in the success of effectively managing our water supplies," said the Council's Industry Co-Chair Dave Hill, who is also the Executive Director of Alberta Irrigation Projects. "We need to change how we all think about and how we all use our water supply – if we don't, all of the other investments and activities will not make a significant difference in sustaining this valuable and limited resource."
