

## Water for Life Implementation Review 2016 to 2019 BACKGROUNDER

- One of the primary tasks of the Alberta Water Council (AWC) is to steward the
  implementation of the Government of Alberta's Water for Life strategy and to champion the
  achievement of the strategy's goals. The AWC facilitates this through the standing <u>Water for</u>
  <u>Life Implementation Review Committee</u>, which convenes every few years to undertake a
  strategic review of the <u>Water for Life</u> implementation progress. The current review covers the
  period from 2016 to 2019 inclusive.
- For this review, the AWC undertook two additional tasks: 1) review and update the committee methodology in line with its standing terms of reference and How-to Guide, and 2) develop a preliminary suite of performance indicators to better assess the implementation of the *Water for Life* strategy and the achievement of goals. (Note: these indicators are to help with the review process, not to audit the Government of Alberta or *Water for Life* partners.)
- This work supports the direction of *the AWC 2019-2021 Business Plan* associated with the *Water for Life* Implementation Review, which identifies the following three strategies:
  - o identify and develop metrics for advancing the Water for Life goals
  - o identify gaps in the implementation of the Water for Life strategy
  - prioritize actions and identify roles and responsibilities for achieving the outcomes of Water for Life
- The 2016 to 2019 Implementation Review aligns with the completion of the 10-year *Water* for Life: action plan (2009) authored by the Government of Alberta. The recommendations provided in this review have the potential to provide direction and to suggest next steps for the provincial government's water stewardship strategy.
- The AWC initiated work drafting a suite of performance indicators during the 2016 to 2019 review process. A consultant was commissioned to provide background information and recommendations. Based on the information provided, the AWC compiled a list of potential performance indicators and distributed them for stakeholder review. However, these indicators will not be used to audit the Government of Alberta or Water for Life partners in future reviews.

The selected indicators could not be tested or verified because of the reduced capacity of AWC stakeholders due to the COVID-19 pandemic. It is recommended that AWC staff test and finalize the indicators before the next review process. The list of potential performance indicators can be found in the *Water for Life* Implementation Review How-To Guide.

- The AWC updated the *Water for Life* Implementation Review How-To Guide to include new processes around the timing of reviews, the information gathering process (including performance indicators), organizing information, and sharing results.
- To inform the 2016 to 2019 review, the AWC used several different methods to gather data and information. Methods included reviewing several pertinent documents and initiatives, distributing a sector survey, holding roundtable discussions with Government of Alberta staff involved in implementation activities, and working with Watershed Planning and Advisory Council managers to gather input from their boards.
- In the 2016 to 2019 *Water for Life* Implementation Review, the AWC observed the following:
  - The actions outlined in the Water for Life: action plan are largely complete, and many actions have become part of daily business for people working in water management and stewardship across the province.
  - Significant progress has been made toward all three goals outlined in the Water for Life strategy; however, it is recognized that some areas (e.g., Healthy Aquatic Ecosystems) need more attention.
- After gathering and synthesizing information, the AWC made the following 15 recommendations to improve *Water for Life* implementation progress and water and watershed management in Alberta:
  - o Recommendation 1. New Water for Life Action Plan
  - o Recommendation 2. Improved Water for Life Reviews
  - o Recommendation 3. Small Systems Standards
  - o Recommendation 4. Drinking Water Safety Plan Audits
  - o Recommendation 5. State of Drinking Water Report
  - o Recommendation 6. One-Water Approach
  - o Recommendation 7. Healthy Aquatic Ecosystems Review
  - o Recommendation 8. Water Use Data
  - o Recommendation 9. Sustainable Economy
  - o Recommendation 10. Improved Modelling
  - o Recommendation 11. Preparedness
  - o Recommendation 12. Education and Outreach
  - o Recommendation 13. Knowledge Integration
  - o Recommendation 14. Partnerships Review
  - o Recommendation 15. Advancing Conservation, Efficiency, and Productivity
