AEP completed the amalgamation and update of the Environmentally Significant Areas and AESA products to create a single product that appropriately identifies both terrestrial and aquatic ESAs. This work will be used to help inform land use planning at the provincial and local levels for use by government, non-government organizations, industry and other stakeholders.
